


MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE FOR COMPASSIONATE ENGAGEMENT(CCE)
MEETING HELD AT KOCHI ON 04-08-2020 and 23-10-2020

The Committee on Compassionate Engagement (CCE) comprising the following members met on 04.08.2020 and 23.10.2020 at Kochi to consider the requests of dependents of deceased Gramin Dak Sevaks for engagement as GDS on compassionate grounds in Kerala Postal Circle.

The last meeting of the CCE was held at the office of the Chief PMG, Thiruvananthapuram on 02.03.2020 and 03.03.2020. The committee is examining 5 cases out of which 3 cases are received matured during the intervening period and 2 cases for review as per the orders of the Competent Authority. While examining each case, the committee kept in view the guidelines contained in Letter No 17-1/2017-GDS dated 30.05.2017, Directorate letter No.17-02/2018-GDS dated 08.03.2019 and subsequent clarifications on the subject issued by the Postal Directorate from time to time.

Engagement of approved cases is subject to the fulfillment of all eligibility conditions. The approved candidates should be engaged only after obtaining the required certificates duly verified, as per Directorate letter no.17-39/2012-GDS dated 20.05.2016. Before issuing engagement order, the Divisional Head should ensure that the approved candidates fulfill the condition of basic computer training, which is a mandatory requirement for recruitment to GDS posts as prescribed vide Directorate Letter No 17-02/2018-GDS dated 08.03.2019.

Cases Reviewed as per the orders of Chief Postmaster General, Kerala Circle :-


The following two requests for compassionate engagement are reviewed as per the orders of the Chief PMG, Kerala Circle.

1. Smt.Soumya P Pillai, S/o Smt.K K Vijayamma, GDS SV, Kanjirappally HO

The CCE which met on 07.03.2018 examined the case of Smt. Soumya P. Pillai on 12/13.04.2018 but did not recommend the case citing the reason as “due to not possessing the required qualification”.

The Chief PMG, Kerala Circle has ordered this CCE to review the case of Smt. Soumya P Pillai. As per rules current as on date of convening the CCE on 04.08.2020 and 23.10.2020, Smt. Soumya P Pillai is not eligible as she has not studied Mathematics in 10th Standard as per the NIOS Secondary School Certificate dated 15.04.2015 and this is compulsory as per Directorate letter no.17-02/2018-GDS dated 08.03.2019. Therefore the case of Smt.Soumya.P.Pillai is not recommended.

2. Shri.Deepu Chandran.C.B, S/o Late Shri.G.Chandran, GDS BPM, Moonnumukku:-


The request of the applicant was examined by the last CCE which met on 07.03.2018, 12/13.04.2018. The case was not recommended by the CCE as the candidate “was not possessing required qualification.”

The Chief PMG, Kerala Circle has ordered to review the case of Shri.Deepu Chandran.C.B. In the notification issued in connection with the GDS online recruitment cycle II, based on Directorate letter no.17-02/2018-GDS dated 08-03-2019, it is mentioned that “Secondary School Examination pass certificate of 10th standard with passing marks in Mathematics and English (having been studied as compulsory or elective subjects) conducted by any recognized Board of School Education by the Government of India/State Governments/Union Territories in India shall be a mandatory educational qualification for all approved categories of Gramin Dak Sevaks”. Shri.Deepu Chandran.C.B meets this educational criterion. The case is reconsidered by the Committee for Compassionate Engagement which met on 04-08-2020 and 23-10-2020 and is recommended for employment under compassionate grounds in relaxation to normal recruitment rules.

The committee has examined 5 cases including 2 review cases and recommended 3 cases as mentioned in **Table-I** at page 4. The post against which the compassionate engagement is considered is also indicated against each. These GDS posts are identified by the concerned Divisional Heads.

Two cases which were not recommended by the Committee are mentioned in Table II at page 4 of this minutes.
